Depart from hotel to Samutsakhon province (travelling time about 1 hrs) drop off at local train station.

10:10 am (approximate) Hop on a local open air train passing through local village and salt farms alongside to Mae klong station (travelling time about an hour), get off at the ended station and walk to visit Railways Market, this market is nicknamed Talat Rom Hup in Thai which means the "umbrella pulldown market". It is one of the largest fresh seafood markets in Thailand, and is centered on the Mae-klong Railway's track. Whenever a train approaches, the awnings and shop fronts are moved back from the rails, to be replaced once the train has passed, this is happened in Thailand only, after visit Railways Market, transfer to visit Damnoen Saduak Floating market, Enjoy a long tail boat trip along canals (about 20 minutes) leading to the market, where hundreds of boats paddle, after visit Damnoen Saduak, we heading transfer back to Bangkok

10.00 a.m. Visit Maya Beach, the world famous beach, just opened for visitors to re-explore its magical white sandy beach.

11.00 a.m. Sightseeing the famous spots in Phi Phi Ley, including Pileh Lagoon, Viking Cave. Snorkeling in front of Viking Cave. (Snorkeling 1 spot, snorkeling spot may be changed depending on tidal condition / suitability)
